

NCYG Tournament Code of Conduct

Failure to abide by the code of conduct will result in corrective action.

Parents & Spectators

Respect Officials: Accept all decisions without public questioning, booing or harassment.

Leave Coaching to the Staff: Do not shout instructions, critique your child's performance or speak to coaching staff regarding your child's playtime during a game or tournament. This is a competitive sport, and playtime is determined by the coaching staff, we ask that parents always remain respectful spectators.

The 24-Hour Rule: As a parent, please wait at least 24 hours or in the event of a multi day tournament, wait until 24 hours after the event has completed before addressing any concerns or complaints with the coaching staff.

Zero Tolerance: Refrain from the use of foul language, violence, and the consumption of alcohol or drugs always while at games, practice or tournament venues.

Players

Demonstrate Sportsmanship: Respect opponents, teammates, and officials, always shaking hands before and after the game.

Play by the Rules: Give your maximum effort and focus on your athletic development rather than simply winning at all costs.

Respect Facilities: Treat the tournament host facilities and equipment with care and respect.

Coaches

Positive Role Modeling: Lead by example with unconditional support, emotional control and fair play.

Athlete Safety: Prioritize the physical and mental well-being of your players above the pressure to win.

Cooperation: Work respectfully with referees, tournament administrators and opposing team staff to ensure smooth matches.
